



Enterprise Europe Network




- European network cofunded by the European Commission

 - Focus on: sustainability, digitalisation and resilience










EIC Accelerator: 8 questions to ask before starting

- □ I have a disruptive innovation project
- □ This project will <u>change my company</u>: it will give it expontial growht
- □ The market potential is <u>international</u> (Europe and beyond)
- □ We are behind the idea stage (POC, demonstrator, small scale): TRL (5) 6 minimum
- But the project is still too risky to interest private investors
- □ A very ambitious future growth of turn-over in 5 years: potentially X8, X10, X15 ...
- □ My company has a <u>team</u> and external supports on which it can count for 3 months of preparation in English
- I really believe in my project, I know EIC is very competitive but to work on this <u>very demanding application</u> will be useful in the future



Financial support to work with a consultant

- Ambition Région International : participer à un projet européen Regional financing scheme allowing companies to get financial support to work with a referenced consulting firm on the European project engineering, strategy, partner search, project submission,

Proofreading committees and pitch training

Proofreading committees

- Proofreading of the application by different experts (*Ceuropean project managers from Bureau Europe and competitiveness clusters, EIC NCP, consultants, …*
- Common and direct feedback during a meeting (on site or online)
- Personalised comments and advices on the application
- Review of the application using the evaluation criteria used by the evaluators of the Commission

Pitch / interview training

- Like on the day of the interview
- 10 minutes of pitch
- 35 minutes of Q&A in English with experts
- Feedback and personalised advices after the session
